I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents' Code of Conduct.

- I will be responsible for my behavior and will be in control of my emotions, as well as those who attend the game/practices as my guest and will not make insulting or vulgar comments to players, parents, officials, or coaches of either team.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and board members at every game, practice or other events.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. I will not instruct him or her to harm any other participants.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will treat both my home field and our host's field with respect and I will pick-up after myself and my party.
- I will not advise the coach on how to do his or her job and will not coach my child during games/practices.
- I will remain in the spectator area during games/practices.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sporting events. I will not drink alcohol at a game, practice or attend one having consumed too much.
- I will remember that weapons of any kind are prohibited on school grounds and practice fields.
- I agree to help my child have a successful youth sports experience by providing transportation to practices and games.
- I will remember that this is a volunteer-based organization, and I will treat those volunteering their time with patience and kindness.
- I will remember that the game is for our youth NOT ADULTS and that participation in youth sports is a privilege, not a right.

I have read the above code of conduct and agree to uphold the terms. I understand that failure to comply with the code of conduct will result in a review by the LPYFC Discipline Committee and could result in potential suspension or dismissal from the program.
