V. Flag Football

a. Season to run 4/30/22-6/18/22

b. Updates - The season is underway and going well. The board discussed a possible increase in registration fees for the fall season. It was noted that Northshore Flag Football is using a Lynnfield Flag Football Facebook page, which has caused confusion to players and families. The board will attempt to have this page removed from Facebook.

VI. Tackle Football & Equipment

- **a.** Updates Football practices will begin on 8/8/22 with the jamboree night occurring on 9/1/22. The board voted unanimously to approve Don Hubbard as head coach of B Team. Equipment fittings will be held on 6/9 for A, B, and C Teams, and 6/11 for JVC and D Teams.
- **b.** JVC and D Team Head Coaches Adam Rystrom will move up to be head coach of JVC Team. We are still in need of a D Team head coach.

VII. Cheer
